



some ideas to spark your imagination:

[illustration A] lace the first few sets of loops, then tie behind the heel or around the ankle

[B] lace the ribbon through the loop closest to the big toe. when the ribbon is halfway through, fold over double and lace and tie as shown. it may be more comfortable to make knots each place the ribbon goes through a loop

[C] tie two different color ribbons to the top-most loops - one at the big toe and one at the small toe. continue to lace the shoe in the basic manner, and you will have lots of extra ribbon to wrap around your ankle and up your leg

[D] after lacing the first couple loops, bring the ends of the ribbon behind your ankle (securing at the ankle loops, if preferred), and tie in front

[E] after lacing through the top-most loops, lace the ribbons along the side loops (be sure the ribbon in the front across the toes is not too loose!), and wrap ends around ankle

[F] the 'airport security' style - lace the ribbons continually through the first couple loops only. the sandal will be quick to slip on and off for walking through the metal detectors!

these are just a few examples of the nearly limitless ways to tie *mohop* sandals! Have fun with the shoes, experiment, and remember, as long as they are comfortable, there's no wrong way to tie them!
